# STEPS TO GET STARTED

## MILITARY, VETERANS, & MILITARY FAMILY MEMBERS

1. **Apply** to Upper Iowa University at [uiu.edu](http://uiu.edu). Click on the "Apply" button in the top right corner of the screen. **Sign up** to create your own username and password, then **log in to complete the application**.

2. **Request copies of official transcripts** of all previous college and high school transcripts. Have transcripts mailed to: **Upper Iowa University-SEC | P.O. Box 1857 | Fayette, Iowa 52142**  
For official digital transcript services, please send transcripts to [IECOperations@uiu.edu](mailto:IECOperations@uiu.edu).

3. **Select the step that fits you below:**

- Active Duty Military** will need to update or create your ArmyIgnitED® account.
  - A. Create a student user account (ArmyIgnitED.army.mil) and click Get Started. You will need your CAC card to access your account.
  - B. Create an educational path and select Upper Iowa University as your educational institution. If you will be taking online classes with UIU please select- "Upper Iowa University-Main" as your campus.
  - C. Meet with an Army Education Counselor for initial TA counseling
  - D. Work with your UIU academic advisor on upcoming sessions and to register for classes.
  - E. Log into ArmyIgnitED.army.mil to request tuition assistance.
- Military Veterans** using VA benefits will need to request a copy of their "Certificate of Eligibility" from [www.va.gov](http://www.va.gov) and send to Military & Veteran Services Center [MVSC@uiu.edu](mailto:MVSC@uiu.edu).
- Military Spouses and Dependents** – UIU's Military Family Grant is available for qualified spouses and dependents beginning in any of UIU's six start dates and is renewed annually with "proof of status." For students to be eligible for the Military Family Grant, they must provide proof of military spouse or dependent status.

4. **Financial Assistance** – If you wish to use financial assistance to help pay for your tuition after your military tuition assistance runs out, or for purchasing/renting books, fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [fafsa.ed.gov](http://fafsa.ed.gov).

- If you do not have your tax return information, please visit the IRS's website at [irs.gov](http://irs.gov) to request a copy of your "Federal Tax Return Transcript" for the appropriate year.

- Upper Iowa University's school code for FAFSA is **001893**

5. Meet with an Upper Iowa University Advisor to discuss degree options and register for classes.

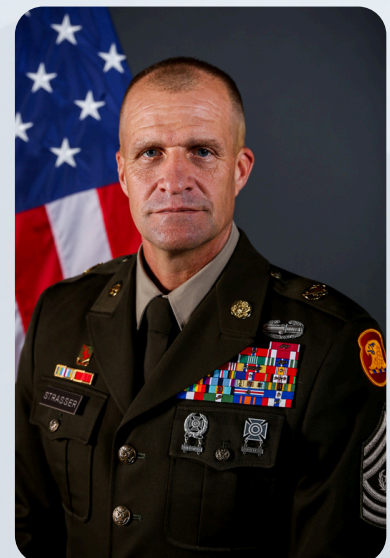

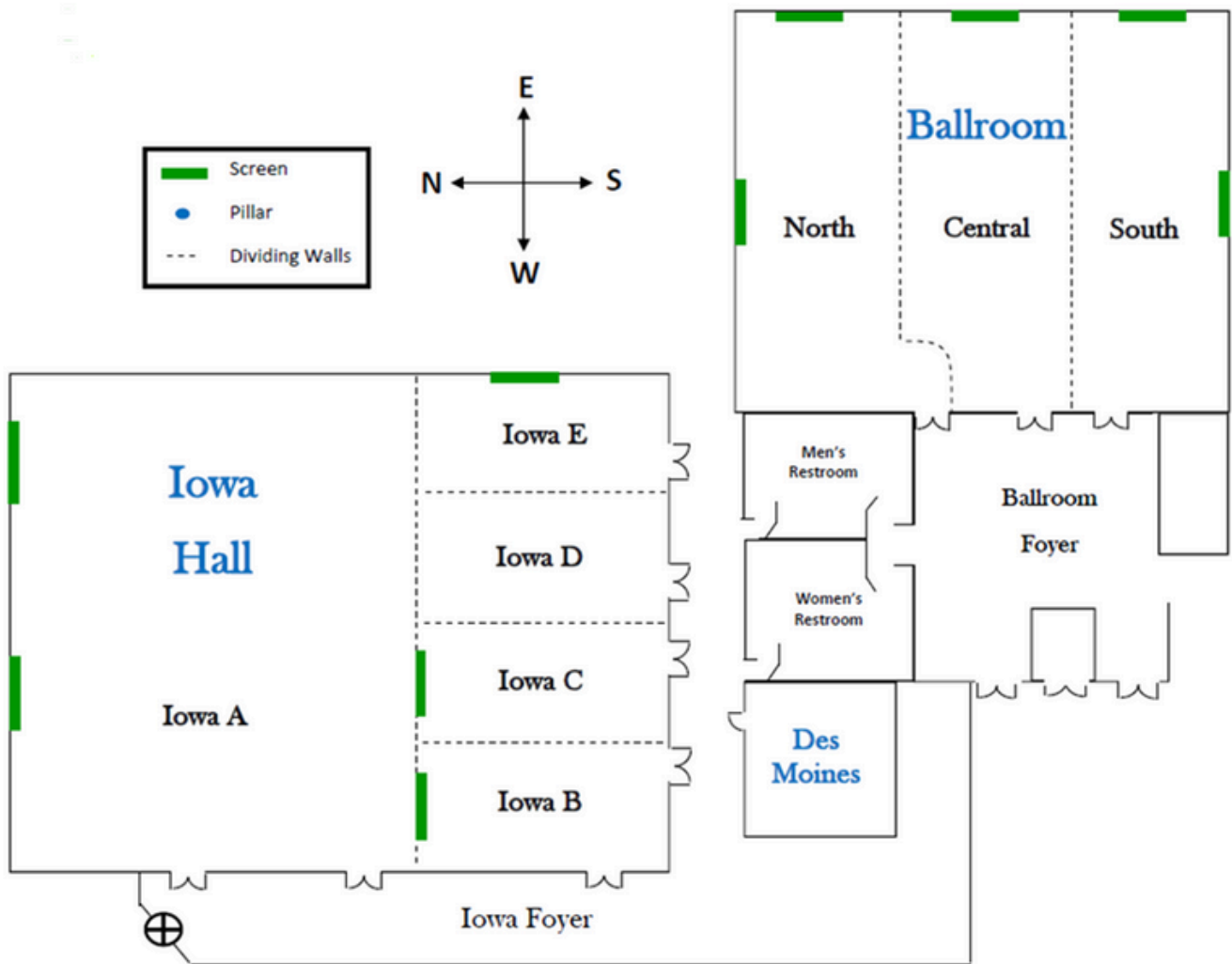

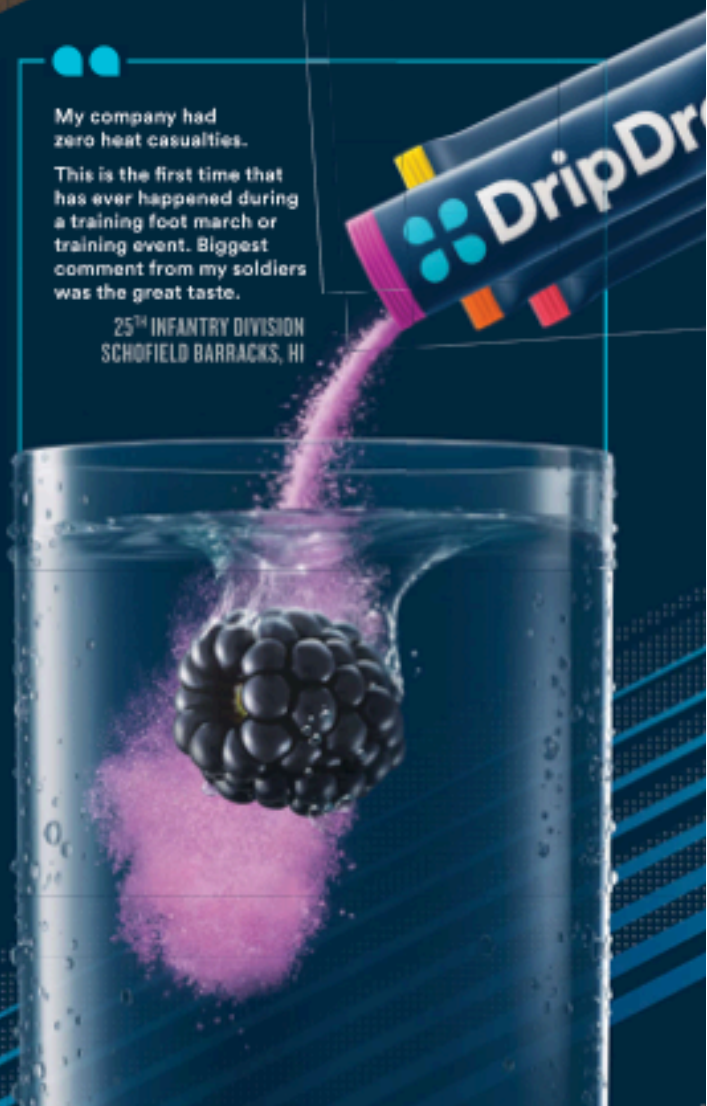

3. Although a single accomplishment may be deemed a qualification for this award, particular consideration should be given to those individuals who have contributed exceptional service of a sustained nature.
4. The intent of the award is to acknowledge achievement in a similar nature to other organizations' halls of fame, positions of honor, highest levels of distinction, etcetera.

## Processing:

Nominations are due to the Remembrance Committee at [peter.g.moeller@gmail.com](mailto:peter.g.moeller@gmail.com), no later than 01 March 2025. Selection process will occur at the quarterly meeting prior to conference. Nomination requirements is full name and a narrative on why the individual should be selected. The Remembrance Committee will vet all nominees and then a selection committee will convene. The selection committee will select the recipient with simple majority vote. The selection committee will consist of previous recipients of this award and the Marilyn Gabbard award. The awards chair will preside as the committee chair but will be a non-voting member. A minimum of three eligible committee members are required to vote. The awards chair will certify the result and prepare the award for presentation. Award will be presented at the annual conference. Nominations do not imply that an award will be granted. Nominees not selected are encouraged to be resubmitted in future years.

4. Any potential short term and long-term effects of the change, positive or negative.
5. Your Name, email address, home address, and phone number.
